



## Dr. Derek Evan Lindsey

March 22, 1972 - August 8, 2019

Dr. Derek Evan Lindsey, 47, husband of Amanda Carole Carter Lindsey, of Hillandale Road, Seneca, passed away Thursday, August 8, 2019, after a swimming accident.

A native of Greenville, SC, he was the son of Carroll Wesley and Mary James Carlton Lindsey of Greenville. He graduated from the University of Georgia College of Veterinary Medicine, and went on to share his love for animals through his work at Clemson Animal Hospital. He was a well known and respected veterinarian who was loved by both his clients and work family. Dr. Lindsey enjoyed collecting unusual guns and jewelry, and spending time with his friends at Deep South Defense. He loved the beach and watching UGA Bulldogs football. He was known as a jokester and was often referred to as the "Master of Strange Trivia." Derek was a wonderful father, husband, son, brother, and friend. He always said that he would be saying "Hey y'all, watch this," as he entered the pearly gates "riding a custom Harley," with his dog Hippo riding shotgun.

In addition to his wife and parents, Dr. Lindsey is survived by his daughters: Brooke, 15, and Claire, 13; brothers: Wesley Lindsey (Ashley) of CA, and Brad Lindsey (Laura) of Charlotte, NC; nieces: Erin, Rowan, and Megan; nephew: Fischer; dogs: Snipper, Mali, and Luna; cats: Loli, Bob, and Chainsaw; his work family at Clemson Animal Hospital and the many special clients who turned into family, and many other close friends and family members.

Derek was preceded in death by his bulldog, Hippo.

A Celebration of Life will be held Thursday, August 15, 2019, from 4:30-7:00 PM, at the Trinity Wesleyan Church Family Life Building. Remarks & Remembrances will begin at 5:00 PM, and the celebration of life will continue afterwards.

“ I first encountered Dr. Lindsey when my dog Scamp was sick and had been diagnosed by another vet but was not improving; by the time I got her to Dr. Lindsey, she was on the verge of death. He proactively treated her for Addison's Disease, saying it wouldn't hurt to do so if she didn't have this condition, which she did. His swift action saved her life and gave us seven more years with her.

A couple of months later, dog Sufi collapsed one evening. I called Dr. Lindsey in a panic, and he met my husband and me at the clinic, where he tried valiantly to save her. Unfortunately, she had suffered a rupture of the blood vessel to the spleen secondary to Hemangiosarcoma and bled out so quickly nothing could have saved her. I'll never forget his face when he had to tell us she was gone.

When it was time to say goodbye to my beloved cat, Rudy, I couldn't bare to have his last moments on Earth be moments of terror, being stuffed in a cat carrier and taken to the dreaded vet's office where, in his mind, nothing ever good happened. Dr. Lindsey graciously came to our house and administered the shot while I held Rudy and he breathed his last. He then began gently wrapped Rudy up in a towel, while I cried into my hands. His face reflected his empathy and pain on my behalf and he pulled me to him for a comforting hug.

Those are the personal reasons that Dr. Lindsey meant so much to me. He shared my most sorrowful, vulnerable moments of my life and that created a singular and powerful intimacy. Multiple that by all the animals and their people he touched and you get a portrait of a man who, while dying much too young, managed to be the recipient of more admiration, gratitude, and love than most people gather in a much-longer tenure on Earth.

I hope these outpourings of love will bring his family peace as they struggle with the senseless loss of such a valuable and beloved member of the Clemson community. I will certainly never forget him and his many kindnesses to my animal companions and me.




