Ann Schade Sloan, 97, wife of the late Philip Sloan, of 190 Sloan Road, Walhalla, passed away Wednesday, December 23, 2020, at Cottingham Hospice House.

A native of Heidelberg, Germany, Mrs. Sloan was the daughter of the late Paul and Louise Spangenberg Schade. She was the owner of Margaret-Ann's fabric shop in Walhalla, SC. She loved making things with her hands, and eager to teach anyone that wanted to learn. Ann was proud of her German heritage and was instrumental in bringing German culture to the people of Walhalla, by being one of the founding members of Oktoberfest. Mrs. Sloan was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church.

Mrs. Sloan is survived by her sons: Philip Martin Sloan of Walhalla, SC, Robert A. Sloan (Laura) of Walhalla, SC and Richard H. Sloan (Lyn) of the Philippines; daughters: Sylvia S. Vaughn (Harris) of Walhalla, SC and Frieda S. Cobb (Jerry) of Walhalla, SC; and many grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
