



Rev. Arthur Glenn Hunter

September 7, 1928 - June 9, 2013

Rev. Arthur Glenn Hunter, 84, of 106 Collingsworth Lane, Greenville, SC died Sunday, June 9, 2013 at McCall Hospice House in Simpsonville, SC.

A native of Charlotte, North Carolina, Mr. Hunter was the son of the late William Arthur and Mary Dora Cealy Hunter. He was a World War II veteran having served in the United States Air Force. Rev. Hunter was a retired Baptist minister, having last served at the Mountain Rest Baptist Church in Mountain Rest from 1972 until his retirement in 1992. Following his retirement in 1992, he was co-owner and acting Administrator of The Foothills Retirement Center. In October of 2005 he was honored as Pastor Emeritus at the church for his faithful service.

Rev. Hunter is survived by two daughters; Merrianna H. Abbott and her husband Charles of Greenville, Melanie H. Doster and her husband Robert of Port Angeles, Washington; four grandchildren, Hunter, Charles Jr., Julie, John, and many nieces, nephews, and loving friends.

In addition to his parents, Rev. Hunter was predeceased by daughter: Renee; brother: Frank and sisters: Helen, Ida, and Francis.

Funeral services will be held at 2:00 PM, Saturday, June 22, 2013 from the Davenport Funeral Home Chapel with burial to follow in Oconee Memorial

Park in Seneca.
