Barbara Judith (Kennedy) Horn, died July 1, 2019, at Cottingham Hospice House, Seneca SC. She was born December 18, 1950 in Stratton Nebraska, to Richard and Valentine (Grivel) Kennedy. The family resided in Albion, NE from 1953 - 1967 before moving to Lincoln, NE. Barbara was a 1969 graduate of Pius X High School, and received her BSRN from the University of Nebraska School of Nursing in Omaha. She attended St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Church in Seneca.

In 1977 Barbara was united in marriage to Thomas R. Horn, of Custer County, Nebraska. They lived in Holdrege, NE, where Barbara worked as a county home health director. Thomas' career enabled them to work and live in New York state, New Jersey, Maryland and South Carolina where they eventually settled in 2001.
