Barbara Lewis Witmer, 82, died June 10, 2026, at home with her husband and family members, after several weeks of excellent care from Hospice and 24/7 Davis Care aides. She had been surrounded by her loving families for the past 2 months, while struggling with complications of myocarditis. She was born in Richmond, VA, August 11, 1943.
