



## Bernice Marie Breithaupt Ebeling

Bernice Marie Breithaupt Ebeling, 71 of Salem, SC died suddenly in a car accident on April 3. "Bunny" shared almost 50 years of married life with her high school sweetheart William, "Bill" Ebeling also of Salem. She is also survived by her three children and their significant others:

Christopher David (and companion Christine Bongiovanni) of San Jose, CA, Jeffrey Steven (and wife Susan) of Commerce, MI, the parents of two granddaughters, Kelsey and Linden; and Rebecca Marie Asbury (and husband

Tom) of Golden, CO who are expecting twin girls in May. Bunny is also survived by two sisters, both of Philadelphia.

A Delta Epsilon Sigma honors graduate of Rosemont College, Bunny was first a stewardess for United Airlines and later for Skylarks of Atlanta. She became a prize winning needle arts expert and founder or co-founder of three chapters of the Embroider's Guild of America. She also worked as a docent for the Alfred I DuPont Institute in Wilmington, DE. A devout Catholic, Bunny was a member of the Altar Society and served on numerous church and school committees in six states. Locally, she has been an active volunteer with Habitat for Humanity and an officer of Paws and Taws western, and Keowee Key ballroom dance clubs.

Because of travel restrictions imposed by the impending birth of the twins,

the family will be unable to gather in full until June. Her ashes are to be interred after a small, informal ceremony on Monday at 3:30PM in the Columbarium at St Paul the Apostle Catholic Church in Seneca. A more formal memorial service with luncheon will be planned for June and announced at a later date.

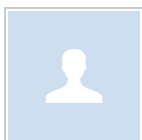
