



## Mr. Bill Schallenberg

September 29, 1922 - March 20, 2014

Bill G. Schallenberg, 91, passed away peacefully at his home surrounded by his family on Thursday, March 20, 2014.

A Californian by birth, Mr. Schallenberg was a southerner by choice, electing to retire in the upstate after living in Hawaii for thirty-five years.

An intrepid sailor, Mr. Schallenberg captained his personal yacht across four Pacific Ocean crossings, the last coming on his 65th birthday. An avid pilot as well, he flew various private planes throughout the Hawaiian Islands, where he owned and ran a popular pizza restaurant known as the Red Baron.

Mr. Schallenberg was a voracious reader of history, with special interests in WWII and the Civil War.

He is survived by his beloved wife of fifty-eight years, Jean Schallenberg; and by his son, William Schallenberg, of Washington, DC; his daughter, Virginia (Brian) Vaughn, of West Union; and three grandchildren: Tom Ward, of Seneca, Jessica Ward, of New York City, and Elizabeth Vaughn, of Simpsonville.
