



## Mr. Calvin Alexander Nixon

January 5, 1927 - May 16, 2015

Calvin Alexander Nixon, 88, husband of the late Edna Blanch Cyrenius Nixon of Seneca passed away on Saturday, May 16, 2015 at Regency Hospital in Greenville.

A native of Detroit, MI, Mr. Nixon was born on January 5, 1927 to his late parents Alexander Clifford Nixon and Hazel Depew Nixon. He received a business degree in business administration from Wayne State University in June of 1949. He spent his entire career in the Detroit advertising business; in several capacities, retiring as a Vice-President in 1987 with thirty-three years at Young and Rubicam, Inc. He married his wife of thirty four years, Edna Cyrenius, on August 17, 1968. The two moved to Seneca in July 1987, where they were both active in numerous organizations. He was raised as a Master Mason on October 26, 1950 in Palestine Lodge #357, F. & A.M., Detroit, MI. He was a life member of the Detroit Adcraft Club. Masonic membership included the Scottish and York Rite Bodies, Shrine, Order of the Eastern Star and many other Masonic organizations. He became Prelate of Detroit Commandery, K. T. #17 in Clemson. He was a member of the Seneca Presbyterian Church and particularly enjoyed the Masonic Order of Knights Templar, hunting, fishing and traveling.

Mr. Nixon is survived by nephews: Donald Nixon of Walnut Creek, CA, Bradley Nixon of Macomb, MI and Richard Pratt of Durango, Co; and three

great nieces.

Mr. Nixon was preceded in death by his brother Robert R. Nixon.

Funeral services will be held at 11:00 AM, Friday, May 22, 2015 at Seneca Presbyterian Church, with entombment to follow at Oconee Memorial Park Mausoleum.

The family will receive friends from 10:00-11:00 AM, prior to the service, at Seneca Presbyterian Church.

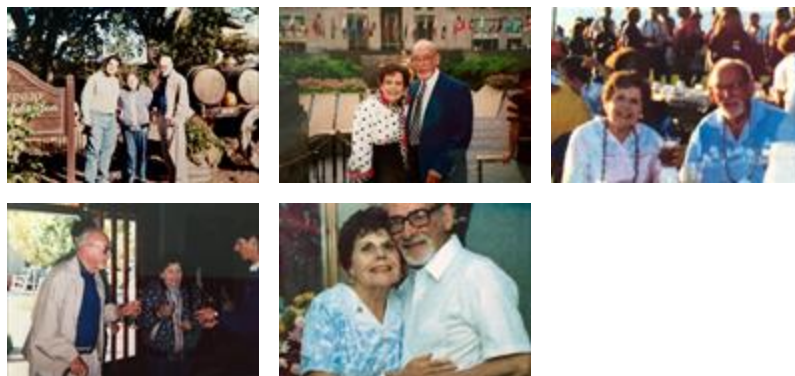
