



Mr. Charles Knight Thompson

Charles Knight Thompson, 95, a lifelong resident of Walhalla, claimed his heavenly reward on February 9, 2015.

Mr. Thompson's passing ended his earthly work in the Lord's service as a 60 year member, Sunday school teacher, deacon and youth program supporter at College Street Baptist Church. Mr. Thompson began his trade as a big rig truck driver during WWII Army service, transporting field artillery. His forty six year career spanned four million miles. Charlie began each day asking the Lord to keep him safe from being a danger to himself or others. He was named South Carolina Trucking Association's Driver of the Year in 1988, and the American Trucking Association's Driver of the Year in 1989. In recognition of these accomplishments, the Director, Motor Vehicle Division, SC Highways and Public Transportation presented Charlie with South Carolina's first Commercial Driver's License. He was a Past Master of Blue Ridge Lodge #92, AFM in Walhalla. Charlie always said all our epitaphs would end like the Old Testament, "...and then he died." (Genesis 9:29)

Mr. Thompson is survived by his daughter: Barbara (David) Cantrell; sons: Charles (Becky), Derrill (Margo) and Troy (Denise); seven grandchildren; and fourteen great-grandchildren.

Mr. Thompson was preceded in death by his beloved wife of 65 years, Mary

Evatt Thompson and his parents: Charlie Creighton and Annie Cobb Thompson; brothers: Edwin, Lloyd and Frank; sisters: Louise (Mart) Waldd, Sara (Jim) Bynum and Frances (Deck) Lee.

A memorial service will be conducted at 11:00 AM, Saturday, March 14, 2015, at College Street Baptist Church.
