Walhalla, SC—Charles “Charlie” Brooks Johnson, 85, husband of Juayne Lillian Moffitt Johnson, of 405 Playground Road, Walhalla, died Monday, March 30, 2009, at his residence.

A native of Spartanburg, SC, Mr. Johnson was the son of the late Walter Agar and Aline Bridwell Johnson. He received his B.S. and M. Ed. at Furman University where he belonged to the Kappa Alpha Order Fraternity. He was a coach and school teacher in the Oconee County School District. Mr. Johnson was a WWII US Army veteran. He was an MP in the 9th Army and served under General Clay in the Battle of the Bulge. Mr. Johnson was a Deacon of First Baptist Church of Walhalla where he had been a member from 1956 to 2009. He was a volunteer fireman and member of the Rotary Club and the Good Guys Golf Club.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Johnson is survived by son, Charles Brooks Johnson, Jr. of Charleston, SC; daughter, Carol Ann Johnson Jones and husband, Larry of Athens, GA; and grandchildren, Lawrence Floyd Jones, Jr., Charles Brooks Johnson, III, Frances Lillian Johnson and Lillian Elizabeth Jones.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2:00 p.m., Friday, April 3, 2009 from First Baptist Church of Walhalla with burial to follow in Heritage Memorial

Gardens.
