Seneca, SC--Christine Patricia Johannes, 69, wife of Frank William Johannes, passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday, February 17, 2009 at Greenville Memorial Hospital.

Born in Detroit, Michigan, on July 12, 1939, she was the eldest child of the late Stanley and Lottie Bronski. She graduated from Dominican High School at age 16, and attended the Detroit School of Business, after which she became an executive secretary at Chrysler Corp. She married in 1961 and had four children over a period of four years. She was a devoted, full time mom to those children until they reached their teenage years, when she began work as a teller at Macomb County Schools and Government Credit Union in Fraser, Michigan. She worked her way up to retire as supervisor and manager of the credit union, and moved to Seneca in 1998. In retirement, she took joy in being a doting grandmother as well as serving as a volunteer in the Oconee Medical Center Auxiliary, where she recently achieved her 2,000 hour award.
