April 10, 1919 - February 2, 2012

Clyde Foster, 92, of 215 Short Cut Road, Westminster, SC, husband of the late Emily Cox Foster, died Thursday, February 2, 2012 at Richard Campbell Veterans Nursing Home, Anderson, SC.

A native of Seneca, he was the son of the late John Washington and Effie McKern Foster. He worked as a weaver at JP Stevens, and also was a custodian at Ravenel Elementary School. He was a veteran of the US Army and served during WWII. He was a lifetime member of the Seneca American Legion Post #120, a member of the Seneca VFW, the Seneca Moose Lodge, and a volunteer at Utica delivering to the local soup kitchen and Golden Corner Food Bank.

Mr. Foster is survived by a sister, Gladys Spearman of Easley, SC; his caretakers, a niece, Deborah Lindsay of Westminster, SC; and nephews, Bobby J. McAlister, USA Retired of Columbia, SC, and John Burdette of Seneca, SC; several great nieces and nephews; and his best buddy "Murphy".

In addition to his wife and parents, Mr. Foster was predeceased by a brother, James Foster, and sisters, Edna Harbin, Eva Watson, and Martha Burdette.

Funeral services will be held Sunday, February 5, 2012 at 2:00 PM at Utica Baptist Church with burial to follow at Oconee Memorial Park.
