



Mr. Clyde Thomas Vissage

April 27, 1923 - January 19, 2017

Clyde Thomas Vissage, 93, husband of the late Gertrude Thompson Vissage, of 321 West Sunsetstrip Drive, Seneca, passed away Thursday, January 19, 2017, at GHS Cottingham Hospice House.

A native of Walhalla, SC, Mr. Vissage was the son of the late Thomas Edward and Sibby Page Vissage. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army and served for three and a half years during World War II. Mr. Vissage later worked as a weaver and as a truck driver for the SC Highway Department and retired after twelve years. He was a member of Bountyland Church of God.

In addition to his wife and parents, Mr. Vissage is preceded in death by his brothers: James and Bunyon Vissage; and sisters: Ozell Capps, Vernell LeRoy, and Sallie Wilson.
