Craig Francis Rogers, 70, husband of Pamela Cornwell Rogers, of Seneca, passed away Sunday, November 19, 2017, at Oconee Memorial Hospital.

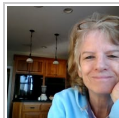
“ *Mr. Craig Francis Rogers*
