



Mrs. Dorothy "Dot" Honea Taylor

Dorothy "Dot" Honea Taylor, 89, wife of James Earl Taylor of Seneca, passed away on Sunday, May 24, 2026 at Cottingham Hospice House.

A native of Oconee County, Mrs. Taylor was the beloved daughter of the late James and Gartrell Taylor Honea. She graduated from Oakway High School, where her story of love began, meeting her husband, James, at a drive-in restaurant in Seneca. From that moment on, she could never quite get rid of him, as he lovingly pursued the girl he would always call his "million-dollar baby" from Harper's five and dime. Mrs. Taylor devoted many years of her life as an inspector at Schlumberger, where she and James shared not only their workdays but also every lunch break side by side. She was a lifelong member of Utica Baptist Church for 66 years where she poured her heart into serving others, especially children. For over six decades, she nurtured young lives through Sunday School, Awana, and her involvement with the Good News Club at Ravenel Elementary. Her kindness and dedication have left a lasting imprint on generations.

In addition to her beloved husband of 68 years, Mrs. Taylor is survived by her sister: Jo Ann Medlin; and multiple nieces and nephews.

In addition to her parents, Mrs. Taylor was preceded in death by brothers: Jerry Dixon Honea and James Medford Honea.

A funeral will be held at 11:00 AM, on Thursday, May 28, 2026 at Utica Baptist Church.
