Seneca, SC—Dorothy Kugler Reymer, a caring Christian mother and veteran, departed this life at age 93 and entered into her heavenly home on Wednesday, June 17, 2009. She was predeceased by her husband of 35 years, Emerson Reymer, her father, Rev. Jay N. Kugler, her mother, Lulu Raney Kugler and two brothers, Paul and Gilbert Kugler.

Born in Marlboro, NY in 1916, Dorothy grew up in NY and Pennsylvania living in parsonages provided by churches her father pastored. She attended Nyack College in NY for one year before joining the Navy Waves in 1943. She served 2 years in the Hospital Corp in NY, caring for returning wounded soldiers. After WWII, Dorothy and Emerson married in 1947. They attended Toccoa Falls College in Toccoa, GA. After graduation in 1950, they moved to Walhalla, SC. She lived there for most of her life. As an accomplished pianist and vocalist, Dorothy expressed her love for Jesus with her “Dorotheo” ministry during her later years in life.

Dorothy is survived by her three daughters: June Swafford and husband, Junior, Sharon Henderson and husband Jim of Seneca, SC and Carolyn Walley and husband Randy of High Point, NC. Also surviving are 9 grandchildren and 3 great-grandchildren.
