Elaine Brown Keane, 80, passed away at Greenville Memorial Hospital surrounded by her family on Friday, September 6th. A celebration of life will be held at a later date.

Elaine was born in Atlanta to the late Mary A. Brown and William A. Brown. She attended Emory at Oxford and Georgia State, majoring in art. Elaine was a talented artist, architectural and interior designer. In 1971 she was the principal designer of one of Architectural Record magazine's 10 best interiors. Travel was one of her favorite activities. A survivor of multiple cancers and health issues, she kept a caustic wit and wry sense of humor.

Elaine was preceded in death by her sister, Linda Brown. She is survived by her husband Terry, children Molly Lilienthal and Jamie Keane, his wife Ashley and grandchildren Brian and Taylor Lilienthal.
