- Elmon J. Estes, Jr., 76, of 906 Shadow Oaks Drive, Seneca, SC, died, Thursday, May 23, 2013 in Greenville Memorial Hospital.

He was born February 2, 1937 in Bonner Springs, Kansas to the late Elmon J. Estes, Sr. and Margaret Louise Cooper Estes. Jack, the name by which he was called, graduated from Fayette High School in 1954. Then he attended the University of Missouri for one semester before transferring to Central Methodist College in Fayette where he graduated in 1959.

After teaching for several years, Jack accepted employment with the federal government. He was located in Kansas City, Missouri, Washington, DC, and Chicago, Illinois before retiring in 2001. At that time, he relocated to Seneca, South Carolina where he made a home for his mother until her death in 2006.

Mr. Estes is survived by his sister, Judith Estes Mounter of Seneca; two nephews, John Mounter of Seneca and Michael Mounter of Columbia; his niece, Kimberly Mounter Day; and grandniece, Sarah Grace Day, both of Greenville.

A private burial will be held in Salisbury, Missouri.
