Walhalla, SC—Elva Brown, 86, of 210 Lakeside Drive, Walhalla, died Monday, November 3, 2008 at Oconee Medical Center.

Born in Oconee County, Miss Brown was the daughter of Arthur and Grace Prince Brown. She was a retired librarian from the Oconee County Library System.

A founder of the Blue Ridge Art Association, she served on the Board for many years. She taught classes in ceramics, weaving and basketry. For several years she was Executive Secretary of the Oconee County Arts Commission. She had a lifelong interest in wildflowers and birding. Miss Brown also served on the Board of the Oconee Heritage Center.
