Seneca, SC—Ferber Lawrence Whitmire, Jr., 83, of 107 Lloyd Street, Seneca, SC, husband of Fay Taylor Whitmire, died Saturday, April 9, 2011 at his residence.

A native of Oconee County, he was the son of the late Ferber Lawrence and Hettie Guntharp Whitmire. He was retired owner/operator of Seneca Feed and Seed and was a World War II veteran of the United States Army. Mr. Whitmire was a member of the Seneca Presbyterian Church, Seneca American Legion Post #120, the Courteney Masonic Lodge and was a member of the Hejaz Shrine. He also, was a 1952 graduate of Clemson University.
