Frances Gambrell Madden, 90, wife of the late Judson E. Madden of 660 Keowee Trail, Seneca, passed away Wednesday, May 20, 2015, at Oconee Memorial Hospital.

A native of Oconee County, Mrs. Madden was the daughter of the late Clyde T. and Agnes Hunnicutt Gambrell. She was a 1941 graduate of Seneca High School and Draughon's Business College. She worked as the secretary to the superintendent at Cannon Mills for forty-three years.
