Frank S. De Lorenzo, 84, husband of Barbara Lamphear De Lorenzo for 64 years, of Seneca, passed away on Wednesday, April 15, 2026, at Brookstone Terrace at Chanticlear in Greenville, SC.

Born in Brooklyn, NY, Mr. De Lorenzo was the son of the late Frank C. and Ann Krug De Lorenzo. He retired from the Suffolk County Police Department in Long Island, NY, where he was named Policeman of the Year in 1984. 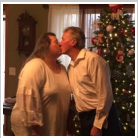
