March 12, 1935 - May 23, 2008

WALHALLA, SC – Edward Eugene “Gene” Rogers, 73, husband of Guynelle Curtis Rogers, of 780 Flat Shoals Road, Walhalla, died Friday, May 23, 2008 at Regency Hospital in Greenville, SC.

A native of Oconee County, SC, he was a son of the late Paul and Lizzie Ledford Rogers and was also preceded in death by two brothers, Cecil Ray Rogers and John Rogers, and a nephew, Cecil Ray Rogers, Jr. Mr. Rogers served with the US Army, and was a deputy with the Oconee County Sheriff’s Department for 15 years.
