



## George Mish Barnett, Jr.

January 17, 1912 - January 11, 2011

Walhalla, SC—George Mish Barnett, Jr., 98, of 121 Mismarber Hill Drive, Walhalla, SC, died peacefully at his residence on Tuesday, January 11, 2011.

Mr. Barnett was born in Richland, SC, on January 17, 1912. He was the son of the late George Mish, Sr. and Maude Cox.

A 1934 graduate of Clemson College, Mr. Barnett worked at Clemson as Foreman of dairy processing plants, Dairy Herd Manager and Associate Dairyman at SC Experiment Station. Later he owned and operated a feed store, dairy farm and poultry farm. He was an investigator for Juvenile and Family Relations Court and Instructor and Head of Animal Technology Department at Tri-County Tech.

He was formerly President of Walhalla Merchants Association; Financial Secretary of St. Luke Methodist Church, Secretary of Brown Swiss Breeders Association. He was a 50 plus year member of the American Legion, where he held several posts; and a member of the Retired Officers Association.

Mr. Barnett was a veteran of WWII, European Theater and a retired LT. COL. in the Army Reserves.

Mr. Barnett is survived by son, George Mish Barnett III; daughters, G. Mishelle Barnett and Mary Barnett Boggs; sister, Grace McGinn; four grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Barnett was predeceased by his wife, Mary Martin Barnett; brothers, J. Albert Barnett, Herschel Barnett, Jacob H. Barnett and John L. Barnett; and sister, Gladys Sims.

A memorial service with military honors will be conducted at 2:00 p.m., Sunday, January 16, 2011, from the Chapel of Davenport Funeral Home, Walhalla.

The family will receive friends prior to the service from 1:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m.
