George Moore, 81, husband of Zenobia Sheriff Moore, of 206 Little Country Lane, Westminster, passed away Monday, February 26, 2018, at Richard M. Campbell Veteran's Nursing Home.

A native of Walhalla, SC, Mr. Moore was the son of the late Elbert Lambkin and Maybelle Carver Moore. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army and retired from Duke Power as a pipe fitter. Mr. Moore never met a stranger and was a member of the Walhalla Football "Chain Gang" for many years. He was a devoted member of Coneross Baptist Church.

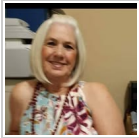
