Glendon Harold Glasier, 83, of Seneca, passed away quietly Saturday after a long string of illnesses.

Glendon was originally from Rodman, NY; a “farm boy” who graduated from Adams Center High School before graduating with Highest Honors in Dairy Technology from the Agricultural Technical Institute in Canton, NY. Upon graduating, he worked in quality control for Kraft Foods. He was honored to have served in the US Army near the DMZ during the Korean conflict as a combat Army medic and radio operator. Glendon was a master craftsman and built homes in Florida, South Carolina, Georgia and New York. He was a Seneca Lions Club member for many years and former president. Most importantly, Glendon loved Jesus and would share his Savior’s story with anyone willingly.
