



## Mr. Harry Francis Davenport

Harry Francis Davenport, Jr., 93, husband of Edwina Mary Englert Davenport, passed away peacefully on Friday, October 24, 2025, surrounded by family.

Born in Wilmerding, PA, Harry Jr. was the son of the late Harry F. and Christina Davenport.
