Walhalla, SC—Henry Dietrich Biemann, III, 46, husband of Kimberly Ann Sosebee Biemann, of 105 Hazelwood Way, Walhalla, SC, died Wednesday, April 22, 2009 at his residence.

A native of Walhalla, SC, Mr. Biemann was the son of Marion Ann Marcom Biemann of Walhalla and the late Henry Dietrich (Dick) Biemann, Jr. He was a full time fire fighter for the Walhalla Fire Department. He was a member of the volunteer fire departments for Walhalla and West Union since age 16. He was a member of St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church and was an Eagle Scout and Scoutmaster for Boy Scout Troop # 45 for four years.

In addition to his wife and mother, Mr. Biemann is survived by sons, Henry Dietrich Biemann, IV and Samuel Charles Biemann, both of Walhalla; sister, Laura A. Sloan of Walhalla; and grandmother, Eunice Marcom of Walhalla.

In addition to his father, Mr. Biemann was predeceased by grandparents, Henry D. and Polly Biemann.

A memorial service will be conducted at 4:00 p.m., Sunday, April 26, 2009 from St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church.

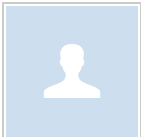
