Walhalla, SC—Henry Ed Cushman, 79, of 301 Jaynes Street, Walhalla, SC, husband of Mary Lou McGuffin Land Cushman, died Wednesday, June 8, 2011, at Richard Campbell Veterans Nursing Center in Anderson, SC.

A native of Walhalla, Mr. Cushman was the son of the late Henry and Ellie Morton Cushman. He was a retired US Army Chief Warrant Officer 2 after 20 years service. His military service included the Korean War and four tours in Vietnam. He was retired from Michelin Corp, Sandy Springs, SC after 15 years service. Mr. Cushman was a former Deacon of Walhalla First Baptist Church; a Perpetual Member and Past Master of Blue Ridge Masonic Lodge #92 and was Secretary of his Lodge for 20 years. He was Past District Deputy Grand Master of the 15th Masonic District, and a Past Worthy Patron of the Walhalla Eastern Star #134. He was also a member of Clemson York Rite.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Cushman is survived by step-son, Kirby D. Land of Seneca; daughter, Robin Smith of Stuart, FL; step-daughter, Rachel Land Smith of Seneca; sister, Louise James of Walhalla; eight grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Cushman was predeceased by his first wife, Mary Sloan Gillespie Cushman; brother, Ralph Cushman; sisters, Irene Johnson, Evelyn Emory and Essie Loudermilk.
