



## Henry Louis Klaren

Henry Louis Klaren, 68, husband of Jeri Alaine Prescott Klaren, of 706 W North Broad Street, Walhalla, SC, died Wednesday, August 25, 2010 at Oconee Medical Center.

Born in Walhalla, on January 2, 1942, Mr. Klaren was the son of the late Charles William 'Bill' Klaren, Sr. and Edith Ellery Rogers Klaren. A thirteen year US Air Force veteran, Mr. Klaren was stationed at Warner Robins AFB where he met his wife of 45 years. While serving in the Air Force, the family lived in Hawaii, New York, Florida and Colorado before moving back to Walhalla in 1982. Mr. Klaren retired from the Army Reserves after 23 years of service. He was a retired employee of Square D Company, member of St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church and a graduate of the Walhalla High School Class of 1960.
