Henry Wayne Cook, 90 years, of Seneca, South Carolina crossed over into the arms of our Heavenly Father on March 15, 2012. He was born April 7th, 1921 in Brooklyn, New York. Henry was a Pearl Harbor survivor who rose to the rank of Aviation Ordinance Chief Petty Officer during World War II.

Most of his youth and adult life was spent in East Rockaway, NY, where he married and raised five children. He was a successful business man who owned and operated his own contracting company. He was a Deacon at Bethany Congregational Church and a volunteer fireman in East Rockaway, NY. He was also a member of the Board of Directors of Wolf Lake Inc., where he retained a second residence for many years. Henry lived in many locations during his long life. Previous residences include: Jekyll Island, Georgia; Wolf Lake, New York; Bamburg, South Carolina; and, The Villages in Florida.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Agnes and John Cook, his sister Edna, his brothers, John and Howard, his first wife of 49 years and the mother of his five children, Lottie Mae, his second wife of 13 years, Naddie, and his great grandson Henrie Phillip Day.

Henry is survived by his wife Pixi Cook of Seneca, South Carolina, his daughters: Phyllis Nelson of Perry, Utah; Margaret Perpetua of Cold Spring, New York; Kathleen O'Rourke of Reseda, California; Nancy DeMaio of
