Jack Edward Masters, 83, husband of Sue Amos Masters, of 111 North Harbour Dr., Seneca, SC, died Monday, October 5, 2015 at Clemson Downs.

A native of Jeffersonville, IN, Mr. Masters was the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Oddust Masters. He served in the U.S. Coast Guard and retired from Proctor and Gamble after 36 years in the aircraft operations division. He was active with the Boy Scouts, was the voice of the Spartans at Turpin High School for 17 years, a past Master of Madeira Masonic Lodge, member of Scottish Rite, and coached little league baseball. Mr. Masters was a member of Seneca Presbyterian Church.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Masters is survived by his sons: Timothy Edward Masters of Dayton, OH and Stephen Earl Masters of Tampa, FL; granddaughter: Amber Lee Masters; and several nieces and nephews.
