James Milton Anderson, 83, husband of Albertine Andrews Anderson, of 228 Keowee Trail, Seneca, passed away Thursday, December 6, 2018, at Richard M. Campbell Veteran's Nursing Home.

A native of Seneca, SC, Mr. Anderson was the son of the late S.L. and Alma Alexander Anderson. He retired from Schlumberger and was a veteran of the U.S. Air Force. Mr. Anderson was a member of Trinity Baptist Church.

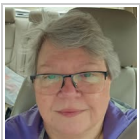

And it was raining very hard. At that time, Meghan was on Septra as a maintenance dose. She got very car sick if she took it within two hours of riding in a car. So we withheld it if she was going anywhere, and would give it to her later. We gave her the dose (since she wasn't going to be in the car for three hours), fed the 4 kids, and loaded them in the car to stay warm and dry. Then we started working. To our surprise, James showed up and offered to take the kids back to their house for the morning so we could focus on packing up our wet campsite. We didn't even think about Meghan's medicine. Later, when we showed up at the Anderson's to collect our children, James filled us in on the trip back he had with the four children. Yes, Meghan threw up ALL over Alexandria and the car. James was a trooper! He had both girls bathed and in clean clothes when we got there. And he had cleaned up his car too. Not one word of complaint! He just rolled with the punches that day and helped us out a great deal. I will always remember his thoughtfulness. He was a good grandfather to all four of those kids! The family was blessed by such a man.
