James Aaron Black, 81, husband of Carolyn Smith Black, of Salem, passed away Thursday, December 6, 2018, at Greenville Memorial Hospital.

A native of Toccoa, GA, Mr. Black was the son of the late Grady and Louise King Black. He was a veteran of the Georgia Air National Guard and had retired from the Georgia State Board of Workers Compensation as a court reporter. Mr. Black was an association representative from Utica Baptist Church for the Beaverdam Baptist Association and attended the South Carolina Southern Baptist Convention meetings as a messenger for Utica Baptist Church. He was a friend of the Baptist Courier and longtime IPTAY supporter, having donated for over fifty-eight years. He was an avid traveler and a member of the Toccoa Lion's Club. Mr. Black was a member of Utica Baptist Church, where he was a teller.
