James Harvey Randles, 72, husband of Elaine Morris Randles, of Seneca, SC, passed away peacefully on Thursday, April 10, 2025 at Cottingham Hospice House.

Born in Knoxville, Tennessee, Mr. Randles was the son of the late Hal Trent Randles and June Large Randles. A proud graduate of the University of Tennessee, he was a lifelong Volunteer fan. He spent his career as a dedicated nuclear engineer with Duke Power, retiring after 36 years of service.
