James "Jim" Lynn Tagtmeyer, 66, husband of Shelley Tagtmeyer, of 835 Keowee School Road, Seneca, passed away on Monday, September 10, 2012.

A native of Fort Wayne, IN, Mr. Tagtmeyer was the son of Fred Louis Tagtmeyer, and the late Helen Grenzenbach Tagtmeyer. Jim was a prayerful man, full of faith, who was raised in the Roman Catholic Church. He was a graduate of Purdue University. During his working life he worked as an Industrial Engineer at 3M; Antique Store Owner, and Auctioneer; Real Estate Agent; Plant Manager at Chicago Dial; Sales Manager at Rea Magnet Wire, Active Industries, and Essex-Brownell; and CEO of Carolina Insulation and Wire. He preformed Volunteer work for Our Daily Bread, Our Daily Rest, Habitat for Humanity, Oconee Memorial Hospital, Senior Solutions, and was also the Head of Finance for Trinity Baptist Church.
