



Mr. James Harold Thomas, Sr.

December 3, 1935 - February 19, 2016

J. Harold Thomas, Sr., 80, husband of the late Gloria Beth Whitworth Thomas, of 375 Earlstead Dr., Walhalla, SC, passed away on Friday, February 19, 2016 at his residence.

A native of Oconee County, Mr. Thomas was the son of the late John “Doc” and Grace Fowler Thomas. He was a member and former Deacon of College Street Baptist Church. He was a founder of the Home Builders Association of Oconee County and donated the lot and helped build the first Habitat for Humanity House in Oconee County. J. Harold served on the first Oconee County Council in 1979, and was elected again in 1996 where he served until 2000. He served as chairman for the Stumphouse Mountain Concerned Citizens for Conservation Committee, and was instrumental in saving Stumphouse Mountain. He was later a member of Oconee Forever. J. Harold was the chairman of the Oconee Scenic Highway Commission and helped ban billboards.

Mr. Thomas is survived by his son: James Harold “Jimmy” Thomas, Jr. and his wife Martha of Walhalla, SC; daughter: Kimberly Ann “Kim” Thomas Williams and her husband Ken of Seneca, SC; grandchildren: Kenneth James Williams, Joshua Michael Thomas and wife Deidre, Matthew Lane Thomas and wife Amanda, Jonathan Brock Williams and wife Cassandra, and Kory Fant Williams and wife Hailey; great-grandchildren: Jack Thomas Williams,

Peyton Marie Williams, Rivers Houston Thomas, Ruth Marie Thomas, Charles Isaac Thomas, and Walt Finley Thomas; and brother John "Dan" Daniel Thomas.

In addition to his wife and parents, J. Harold was preceded in death by two sons: Steven Gregory and Jeffery Lane Thomas, and two sisters Margaret Thomas Copeland, and Betty Thomas King.

Funeral services will be conducted at 4:00 PM on Monday, February 22, 2016, at College Street Baptist Church.
