Seneca, SC—James Waldow Emerson, 80, of 401 Wolf Stake Church Road, Seneca, SC, husband of Lillian Queen Emerson, died Thursday, January 6, 2011, at Cottingham Hospice House.

A native of Oconee County, Mr. Emerson was the son of the late Robert Theodore and Inez Cross Emerson. He was a self employed mechanic and cattle farmer. Mr. Emerson was a US Army veteran, having served in the Korean Conflict. He was a member of the American Legion and Blue Ridge Masonic Lodge #92. He was of the Baptist faith.

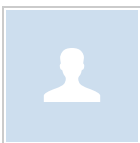
