



## James "Jimmy" Robert Rogers

June 18, 1933 - December 18, 2011

James Robert Rogers, 78, of 25 Lakeshore Drive, Walhalla, SC, died Sunday, December 18, 2011 at Oconee Medical Center. He was twice married, first to the late Lois (Judy) Longfellow Rogers and presently to Deborah Barton Rogers.

A native of Oconee County, Mr. Rogers was the son of the late Bobbie Lee and Mary Virginia Potts Rogers. He was the owner/operator of Jimmy Rogers House of Music and a lifelong musician. He was a veteran in the US Air Force and served in the Korean War. He attended Rocky Knoll Baptist Church and was a member of the Blue Ridge Masonic Lodge and the Hejaz Shrine Temple.
