Beloved husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, special friend, John Frank Day, 74, of Seneca, met his heavenly father on Sunday evening, March 1st, peacefully, at home. He was surrounded by his family, and loved dearly by his wife, Gwen Day of 52 years, son Evans Day (wife Sandy) daughter Julie Day-Weber, life-long brothers: Phil Harrison (wife Miriam), Keith Threlkeld (wife Jennifer). He was a member of the Lions Club and the Kiwanis in Greenville. Also served on the Greenville Chamber of Commerce, the Army National Guard, and as a deacon of Hilton Head Island First Baptist Church. Chef John "extraordinaire" enjoyed cooking Wednesday night dinner at church and loved serving donuts on Sunday mornings with his

son.
