Dr. John Connor Graves, 88, beloved husband of Connie Graves, of Salem, passed away on Wednesday, February 12, 2025.

Born in Detroit, MI, Dr. Graves was the son of the late John Conner Graves and Mary Louella Ainsworth. John graduated from Michigan State University with a Doctorate in Psychology. His education served to propel him through a long career in education and training on the local, state, and national levels. He worked in high schools, universities, corporations, and communities, bridging differences between people for unified solutions for improvement and change. On the national level, he worked as the training director for Rockwell International, and the UAW/GM joint training initiative. Education, especially of underserved communities, and workforce development motivated him throughout his career.

While he was known to be a hard worker, his family was equally, if not more important to him. He was a loving father and role model to his four children. Papa, as he was known to his grandchildren, will be remembered as an incredible storyteller, an inspiring conversationalist, a lifelong teacher and the best friend ever. He was a trusted, guiding light for many lives.

When he wasn't working you could find him out on his porch birdwatching, reading a book or telling one of his favorite jokes. His favorite place to be was

on the water, fishing with his family and the love of his life Connie.
