John James O'Mahoney, born in Brooklyn, NY, on September 8, 1937, returned to his maker at 3:00 PM, Saturday, July 9, 2022. He is survived by his wife of 50 years, Patricia; son: Thomas Neil; sister: Mary O'Donnell; sister-in-law: Catherine Alcuri; and many nieces and nephews.

Mr. O'Mahoney is preceded in death by his parents: Cornelius and Catherine Gallagher O'Mahoney; and sisters: Margaret Hesse, Catherine Gallagher, and Constance Twilley.

While John was a Brother of the Sacred Heart, he served as a 7th-grade teacher in St. Luke's and St. Philip Neri Elementary Schools in the Bronx, NY; and late, he was a history teacher and assistant principal in Bishop Reilly High School in Queens, NY. Attending New York area colleges part-time, John completed a Bachelor's Degree and earned two Master's Degrees.

He taught and became principal of the public school in Dobbs Ferry, NY. In the Southampton School District, the deceased served as principal of the Intermediate School, from which he retired in 1996.

In 1999, the O'Mahoney family moved to the Keowee Key Community, where John enjoyed teaching the monthly History Group, volunteering as a history teacher for the Osher Life Long Learning Program (Olli Program), and serving

as an adjunct professor at Tri-County Technical College.

In a magnificently productive, personal and professional life John O'Mahoney exemplified integrity, dedication, unfailing good humor and love. The world will never see his like again. John will be missed and loved always.
