



## Mr. John Sanders Reeves, Jr.

John Sanders Reeves, Jr., 79, husband of Nancye Johnson Williams Reeves, of Seneca, passed away on Monday, March 30, 2026 at Greenville Memorial Hospital.

Born in Moncks Corner, SC, he was the son of the late John Sanders Reeves, Sr. and Nell Seawright Reeves. He was a devoted follower of Christ and a member of New Hope Baptist Church, where he served as a deacon and long-time Sunday school teacher. He was loved and respected by his church family.
