



## John Robert Moosbrugger

March 21, 1940 - March 26, 2012

John Robert Moosbrugger, 72, of 632 North Flagship Drive, Salem, SC, husband of Mary Coultrip Moosbrugger, died Monday, March 26, 2012 at St. Anthony's Hospital in St. Petersburg, FL.

A native of Skokie, IL, Mr. Moosbrugger was the son of the late Frank J. and Helena Stevens Moosbrugger. He graduated from Notre Dame University with a degree in Finance. He was the Director of Transportation with US Can Company in Oakbrook, IL, and served in the army reserves. Mr. Moosbrugger was a member of St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Church and was Treasurer of Our Daily Bread for fourteen years. He helped build the new soup kitchen in Seneca, SC, was president of Kiwanis, was president of Friends of Italy and was head of the Kayak Group.
