John Pinckney Workman, 83, husband of Elinor Ammons Workman, of 703 Sherwood Dr., Seneca, SC, passed away on Saturday, December 19, 2015 at his home.

A native of Kinards, SC, Mr. Workman was the son of the late Pinckney Clair Workman and Margaret Young Workman. He was a graduate of Clemson University and a U.S. Army veteran. He retired from a 42 year career in the food industry, having worked at both Sealtest Foods and Van Leer Chocolate Company. He served lay leadership roles in Presbyterian churches in Wilson, NC, and in Walhalla, SC. He also served on the board of directors of the Chattooga Lake Club in Mountain Rest, SC, where he and his wife maintained a second home.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Workman is survived by his daughters: Jane Richards (Randy) of Aurora, CO and Elizabeth Davis (Ron) of Roanoke, VA; son, John Workman, Jr. (Jeanne) of Omaha, NE; six grandchildren; two great-grandchildren; two brothers; and three sisters.
