Joseph Edward "Jed" Duty, Jr, MD, 84, husband of Margaret Ellen Cullison Duty, of Seneca, passed away on Saturday, September 23, 2023, at his home.

A native of Toledo, OH, Dr. Duty was the son of the late Joseph Edward Duty, Sr., MD, and Sara Louise Scarborough Duty. He was a graduate of the University of Toledo and The Ohio State University. Dr. Duty served as a Captain in the United States Army in Vietnam where he received a citation award for exemplary service at the Irwin Military Hospital, and was active in the Keowee History Club, Senior Softball, Senior Basketball, and SAE Fraternity.
