Joseph Michael Landry, 69, husband of Mary Lee Clapp Landry, of 24 Port Tack Drive, Salem, SC, died Saturday, February 7, 2009 at his residence.

A native of Madison, IN, Mr. Landry was the son of the late Richard Joseph and Mary Ruth Dunn Landry. He retired from Rexnord Corp as President of Engineered Chain and Idler Divisions.

Mr. Landry was an Ordained Deacon in the First Baptist Church in Madison, IN and coordinated the Macedonia Ministry (Lay Witness Program for the State of IN); He was Assistant Scout Master of Jefferson County, IN; served on the Boy Scout Board; was President of Madison Indiana Kiwanis Club; and served as United Way Drive Chairman.

In Springfield, MA, Mr. Landry served on the Board of Directors for Junior Chamber of Commerce; the Campus Crusade and served on Mature Industry Appointed Commission of MA by Governor Dukakis.

In Oconee County, Mr. Landry was an ordained Elder of the Walhalla Presbyterian Church, he served on the stewardship and finance committee and was a coordinator of Shepherd Ministry. He was active in the Keowee Key Men's Golf Association and in bowling leagues. He rolled a 299 game in 1999 in the couples league in Anderson, SC. Mr. Landry and son Rick won the Men's Member Guest Golf Tournament at Keowee Key Country Club in 2002.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Landry is survived by son, Dr. Richard D. Landry and wife, Julie of West Suffield, CT; brother, Frank E. Landry and wife, Lucia of Audubon, PA; and sisters, Sharon Landry Hord and husband, Don of Longs, SC and Linda Lee Dunscombe and husband, Jim of Tuscaloosa, AL.

Funeral services will be conducted at 11:00 AM, Wednesday, February 11, 2009 from Walhalla Presbyterian Church with burial to follow in Oconee Memorial Park, Seneca, SC.
