Joseph Earl "Jake" Robinson, Jr., 85, husband of Elizabeth Cathcart Robinson, formerly of Morningside Assisted Living in Seneca, died Saturday, February 26, 2011 at the Richard M. Campbell Veterans Nursing Home in Anderson.

A native of Oconee County, Mr. Robinson was the son of the late J. E. and Sallie Owens Robinson. He was a Veteran of the United States Navy and was retired after forty years from the South Carolina Highway Patrol. Mr. Robinson was a member of Trinity Baptist Church, Seneca Masonic Lodge #185 and the Seneca American Legion Post #120.
