Lady Kent West Zetwick, 85, of Walhalla, SC, passed away May 11, 2012, following a short battle with cancer. She was married to the late Robert R. Zetwick for 59 years, and they lived in Walhalla for 48 years.

Mrs. Zetwick was born in Selma, AL to the late James Kent West and Mary Louise Clark West. Growing up on a farm, she loved hunting, fishing, horseback riding, raising farm animals, and playing basketball and softball. Mrs. Zetwick is survived by sons, Robert J. Zetwick and wife Deborah D. of Plano, TX, and James K. Zetwick of Palm Bay, FL.

In addition to her husband and parents, Mrs. Zetwick was predeceased by ten brothers and sisters.
