



## Lawrence Haskell (Buck) Buchanan

September 24, 1923 - February 28, 2012

Lawrence Haskell (Buck) Buchanan, 88, of 120 Downs Blvd, Clemson, SC, died Tuesday, February 28, 2012 at Clemson Downs.

A native of Cleveland, SC, Mr. Buchanan was the son of the late Grover C. and Laura Bryant Buchanan. Mr. Buchanan was a 1948 graduate of Clemson College (later Clemson University) earning a Bachelor's Degree in Textile Engineering. He joined JP Stevens Company shortly thereafter and had a rewarding career in yarn sales until he retired from JP Stevens (Greensboro, NC) in 1980. After his retirement from JP Stevens, he launched his own company, Tiger Yarns, Inc. which he operated for fifteen years from his home in Clemson, SC. Buck was also a former member of the Clemson Rotary Club, St. Andrews Society of Upper South Carolina, and the Buchanan Society of Scotland. He was a lifelong member of IPTAY and a proud supporter of all things CLEMSON, GOLF, and SCOTLAND.

Mr. Buchanan is survived by two sons, Joe Thomas Buchanan (Cathi) of Greensboro, NC, and Lawrence R. Buchanan (Nora) of Reston, VA; and sister, Alma B. Ledford of Travelers Rest, SC.

Mr. Buchanan was preceded in death by his wives, Frances Barnett Buchanan and Wilma Hendrix Buchanan.

Funeral services will be held at 11:00 AM Saturday, March, 3, 2012 at Davenport Funeral Home Chapel, with burial to follow at Mountain View Memorial Park in Travelers Rest, SC at 2:00 PM.
